A home is a sanctuary. A place to relax, to accommodate both the dearest friends and family and the newest acquaintances. A place of peace. For Nancy Price, founder and principal of her eponymous firm, a restful residence is created through visually interesting—and often contrasting—pieces that coexist in just the right balance. She and her team establish neutral “bones” first, then layer in art, textiles, and accessories, many times selected from their global showroom. At the heart of creating a residential haven are the homeowners and their lifestyle; every design choice is based on a personal relationship.
